She also provided a great meeting room at her community center and lunch sandwich fixings, potato salad and chips with assorted drinks.

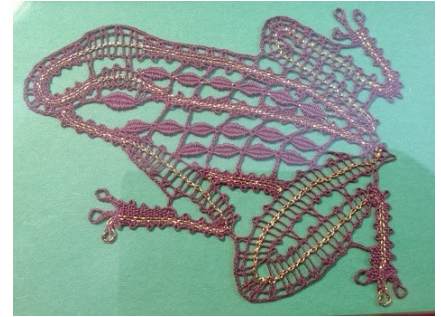
Jan Brand finished her bauble ready to put on some scissors.



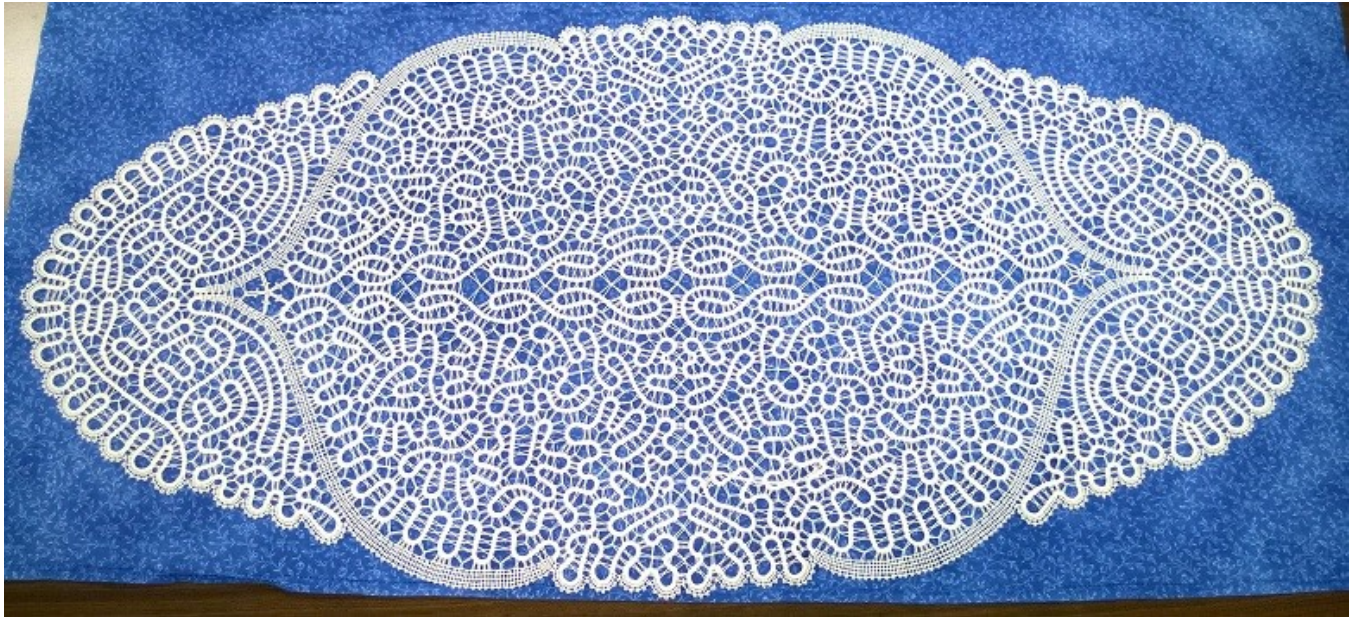


Sandra did some embroidery that looks like lace and a Romanian Point Fish. Very Pretty.

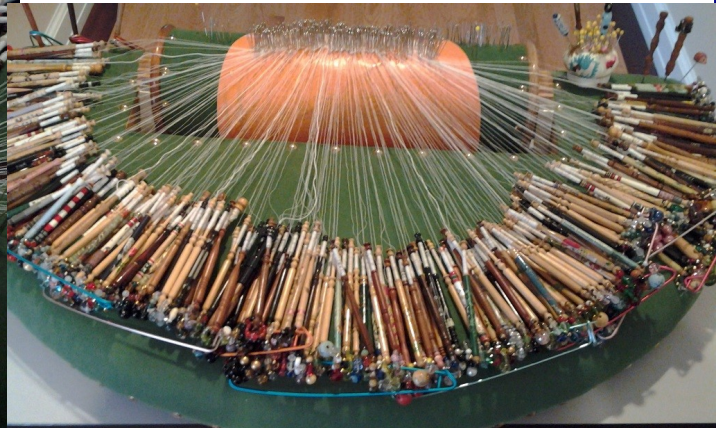
Betty Mac Donald has done a wonderful bobbin lace interpretation of Van Gogh's painting; we are blowing the lace up to mural size. My plan is to suspend all the lace stars from above, in the sky line, of the "Starry Night" using fishing line. I have attached an image of the painting. I will group the stars by color in the sky to coincide with the colors of the skyline. So you may choose any color from the painting for your star. Any size and any technique is acceptable. The stars will be returned after the event.

Best if the stars are flat and starched. Before hanging them at the congress I plan to iron creases in them to give them structure.

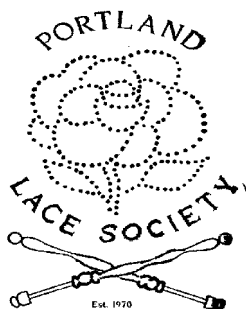
Miss Channer's Mat project by Alice Howell
