With a little edit, cut and paste, here we all are. We were learning a new technique of making "baubles" and Delsey had great instructions for us.


She also provided a great meeting room at her community center and lunch sandwich fixings, potato salad and chips with assorted drinks.

Beverly made a very large Idrija Doily that turned out very nice.






OIDFA National Stand at Ljubljana: Jun 24-26 - OIDFA in Ljubljana, Slovenia
