October 1st Meeting was short just to go over the plans for Saturday's Lace Day.

**Minutes—November 5, 2015**

Meeting was called to order by President Beverly Davis with 14 in attendance. Minutes were approved as printed.

Treasurer's report was given and approved. Total Equity is \$44,681.07 with \$4,175.88 in checking and \$39,474.54 in the Money Market Account. From Lace Day the Straw-Draw made \$81.42, Raffle \$129, and consignments \$478.

Lynda Libby had further information on the Name Tag options. \$12 for a magnetic one, \$11 for the pin, \$3 for holes to be drilled. We discussed several options and combinations and Lynda will get more information for next meeting.

We discussed several options for reimbursement of the host for classes. It was decided that instead of an itemized list of expenses, the host would get their class for free. If there are any unusual expenses, they are welcome to keep receipts and get reimbursed for those.

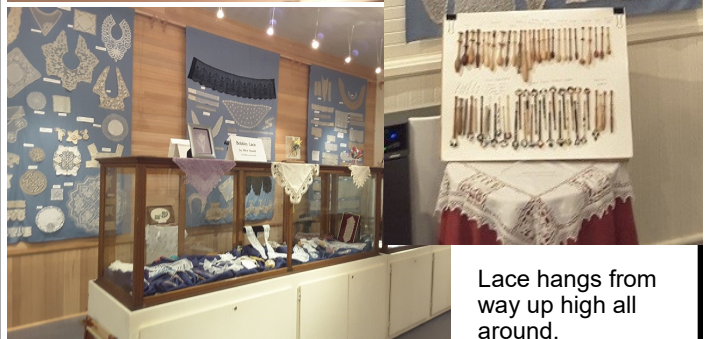

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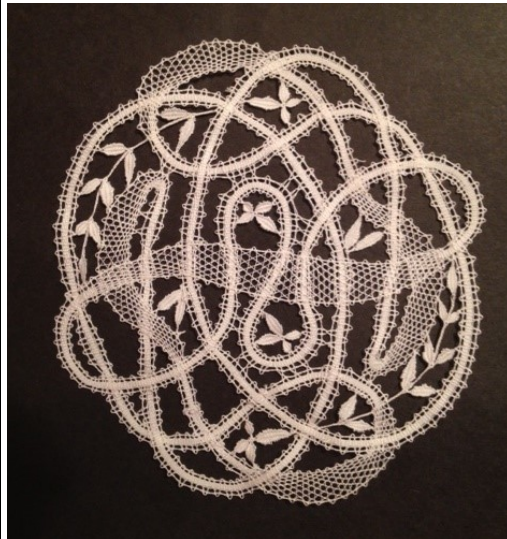

We all liked the beads and rhinestones so you will see lots of glitter in our projects. Seen around Jackie's house — Opal and Sherri hard at work.



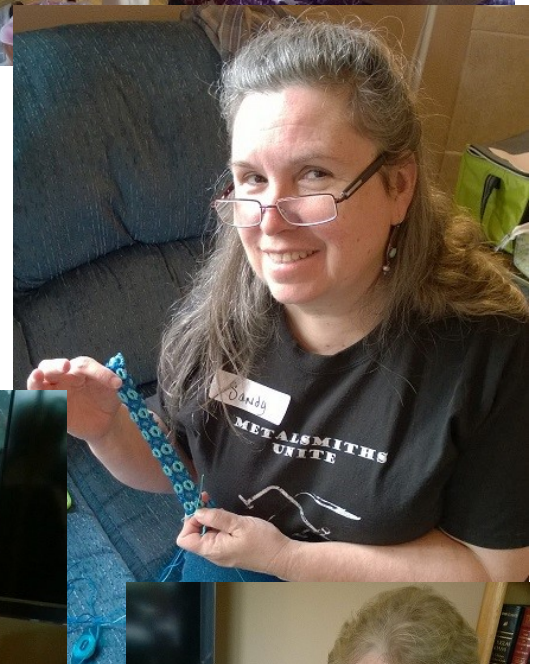

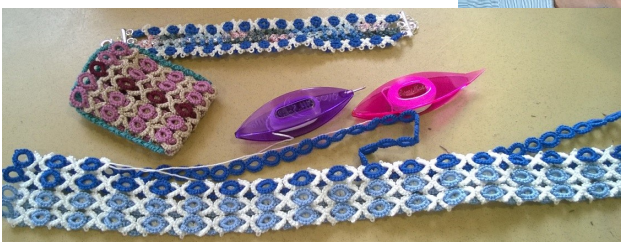
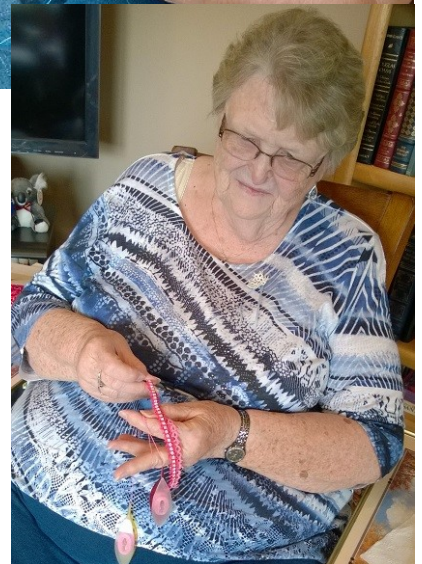
Pauline got her sparkle down the middle of her bracelet.

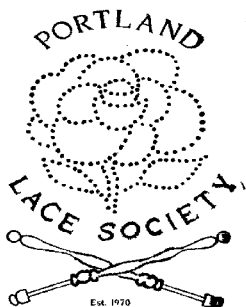
