



THREAD CATCHER BOX


- 1. Cut the paper into a 6 x 10 inch (25 x 40cm) rectangle.
- 2. Mark the 6 inch (15.25cm) length into 3 x 2 (5cm) inch squares and fold. Unfold the paper.
- 3. Mark the 10 inch length into 5 x 2 inch (5cm) squares and fold.
- 4. Unfold the paper and using the following diagram (Fig a) as a guide, remove the shaded square 1 and cut on the dotted lines to the first fold.



5. With wrong side facing, fold and glue shaded square 2 on the next square. This forms the base of the box. (Fig b)



6. Fold the top third section of the rectangle to the first fold. Take the top corner of each square and fold it diagonally to meet the opposite corner. Repeat in the opposite direction. Keep the diagonal folds parallel. (Fig c)



- 7. Fold the 8 squares to form a box. Ensure that the diagonal folds indent into the centre of the box. Insert the tab between the first and second fold. Adjust to fit if necessary before gluing into place.
- 8. Fold and glue the cut flaps together to close the bottom of the box.
- 9. To collapse the box pinch the diagonal corners at the bottom of the box then press the open top. Use pressure on the folds to keep them in place.
