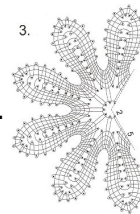

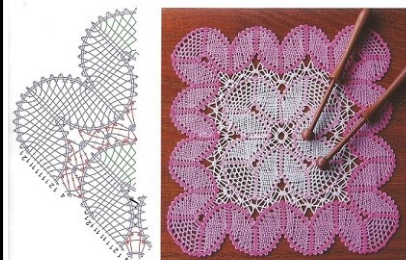
Remember—every 2nd Saturday at The Mill 10 am to noon is an opportunity to share our lace addiction.

Flat, round, square and three dimensional flowers, etc.



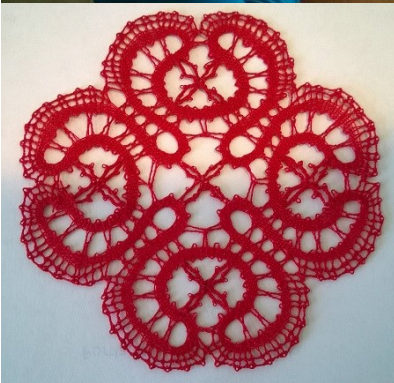
Something for everyone.

You go girl!

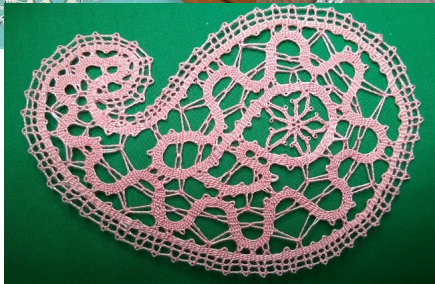
Carol didn't come to Idrija class, but she is going to OIDFA so has been practicing and made the little flower and some earrings.

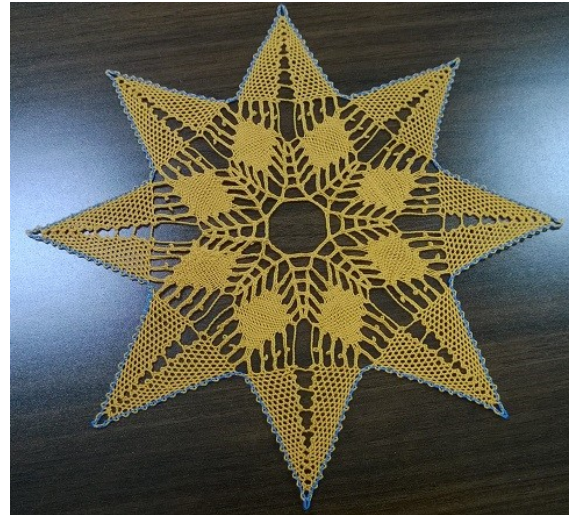

I finished my 2nd star recently. If you have any in the works, complete and give them to Bev or Carol.

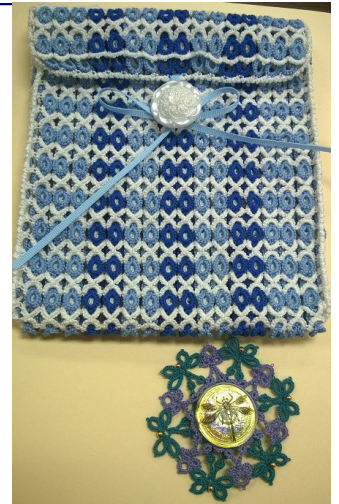


Our tatters were busy before and after Shuttlebirds

Beverly did a purse with the X&O design before she went and then did the nice little dragonfly button trim for a class.

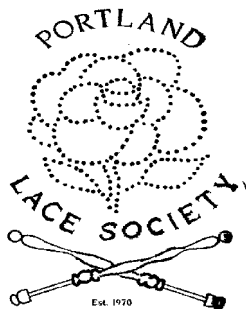
Jackie made several items with new techniques learned from her classes.
