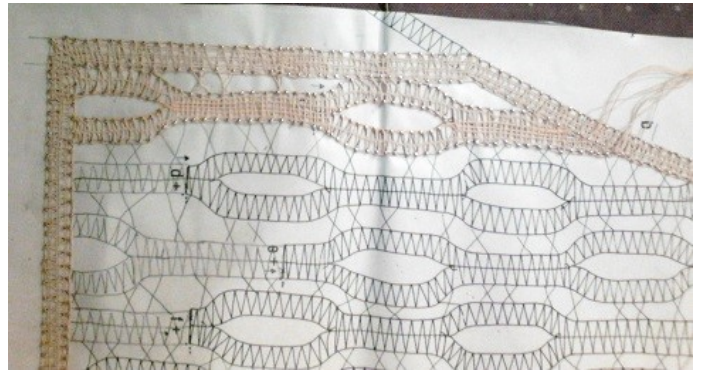
The stands that Beverly and I got were not finished so we are busy sanding, staining and sealing those up. Hopefully we will have pictures by next issue.



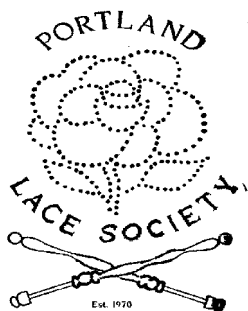
Carol has started a large vest project and will show us updates as she works through it. Here is the beginning —
