



Message from Allie

Here are the two projects that I taught at IOLI last summer. The little blossom was a great starter project and students can use Gold-

schild 60, 30 Idrija cotton or Londonderry linen 80/3. The mat was worked in Goldschild 60 which is what is recommended for Idrija wide tape. Tom is selling it but only has white.

(Note: Bev and I will look for some colors at Winter Lace and bring some back.)

Londonderry and cotton are a bit thinner but still work.

Narrow tape patterns have not been chosen yet as I will give them an option of working on a

pattern they purchased at OIDfA.

If you want to do narrow tape and don't have a pattern, mark that option and Allie will contact you.
