Curled Ring Homework:

Please do this section (shown in gold in picture) before coming to class. This section takes 3 yards on one shuttle if you are using size 20 thread. If you are using size 10 or 3,

please adjust the amount of thread needed. With a single color, tat a 5 ring cinquefoil:

R 6ds - 14 - 6 ds.

R 6ds + 14 - 6 ds. (3 times)

R 6ds + 14 + 6 ds

In rings 2 through 5, join to the last picot of previous ring.

Classwork:

In addition, you will need the following items Curled ring round - 4 yards on chain thread of a different shade or color

Picot gauge, scissors, and your usual tatting tools For the second project, you will need One shuttle: 4 yards for the outside section

2.5 yards for the curled ring section (Colors of your choice)

A bead kit containing silver and pearl beads will be included for this project (no charge)




