The subject is putting beads between split rings for a bracelet (or really short and you could do earrings).



Materials: size 10 thread, Tatting Needle size 5, 9-12 beads that the tatting needle will pass through, desired findings for bracelet (jump rings, clasp, etc.).



Wind three yards and all beads on shuttle, leave three yards for tatting needle. If you don't have a needle I will have some you can use to try this with.

Tina will join us and have some for sale if you like this method and don't have a needle.

Use your imagination. We were thinking in class that we might like a smaller bead on each end of the larger bead. Get creative and let's have some fun.

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Beverly had this piece at McMinnville meeting, If you look close, the flower centers have some interesting circles in them.

Quilting, bobbin lace, tatting. Wow, what a show!

Well, now we come to daughter, and with such inspiration we can see where she comes up with the habit of taking on and finishing beautiful projects.

So Joyce has this to say about her latest great achievement.- - -



At the 2016 OIDFA congress in Slovenia I purchased the Torchon Shawl pattern called Chal Pico Candelaria from Elena Diaz along with 4 spools of red silk thread.

This pattern is made in one piece in the shape of a triangle and starts with 10 pairs of bobbins. A pair of bobbins is added along the top straight edge. By the time I reached the center of the triangle, a total of 588 bobbins were utilized. This project took 1100+ hours, is 80" x 40" and took me 25 months to complete.

Since I didn't have a pillow big enough to fit the pattern, I used lots of pillow blocks on a large table and when I reached the center of the shawl and had to turn, I set up another table to make a L shape layout. Once I completed the center turn I was able to remove the second table. From then on it was a race to the finish which took me another 15 months.

I could have had this completed sooner but I was also working on an Idrija vest that took 2 1/2 years to complete.
