Dear Lace Maker,

Kathy and I are pleased to announce the completion of the pattern book she has been working on entitled, *"For the Love of Lace"*. It is 28 pages in length and contains 14 bobbin lace patterns, both original designs and patterns that have been adapted from existing pieces of bobbin lace.

Kathy says, "I have tried to include patterns that any level of lace maker can make. There are a few simple patterns as well as others that more experienced lace makers will find challenging".

Some of the patterns included are Black-Eyed Susans, a Celtic de Loop, Halloween Spider and Pumpkin, a Torchon heart edging, several tape lace patterns, a Floral Buckspoint Edging, and several other whimsical patterns.

This is a project I urged Kathy to undertake after a stroke left her partially paralyzed in 2017 and rendered her unable to continue making bobbin lace. The book was mentioned in a recent article printed about Kathy and I in the last International Organization of Laces' Bulletin. Upon request, Kathy will be happy to sign a copy for you. Just tell her what you'd like her to write when ordering.

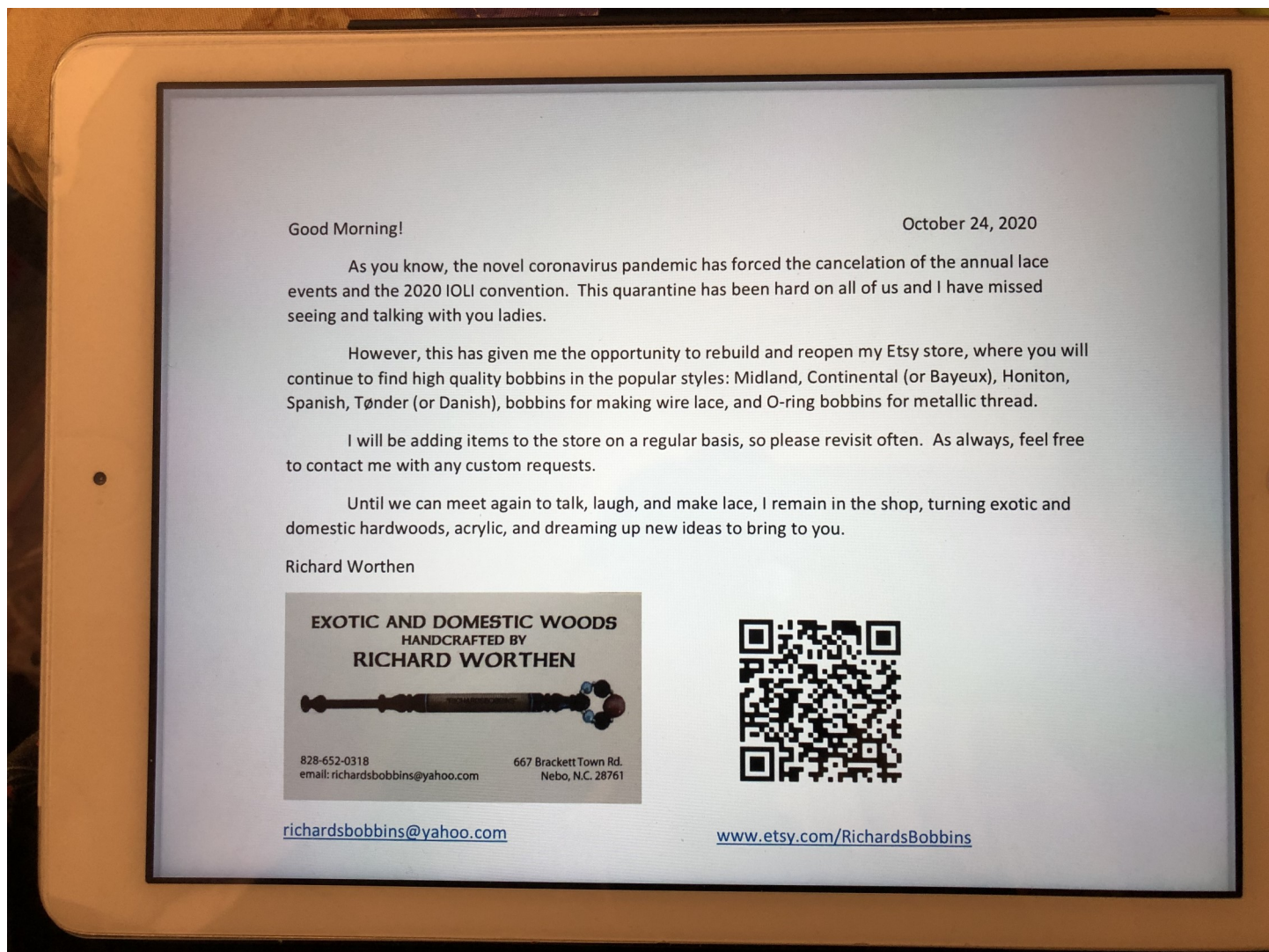
