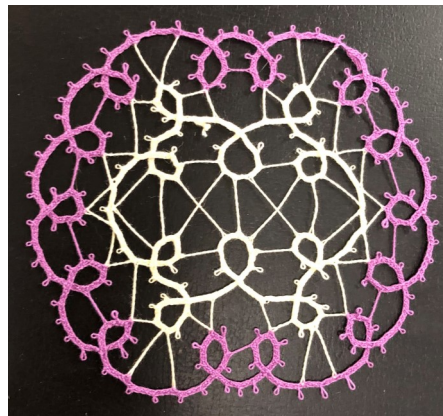

Beverly worked this piece of Fiandra with three pair as a sample of something we might be interested in for our Un-Convention.

It is an interesting method of making lace. Sounding easy since it is only three pair, but that also makes it not so easy since you have to keep a certain sequence to make a nice flat plait of the tape.

No pins are used on the tape but the picots and brides (twisted at the time of attachment) are the only way to keep the shape.

All of these items are temporarily suspended.
