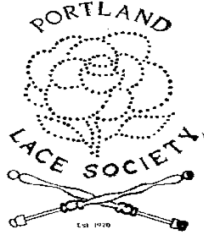

Minutes for Portland Lace Society Meeting, March 5, 2026

President, Melissa Hallnor called the meeting to order with 15 members present. Minutes approved. Two visitors welcomed.

Meeting dates for the future will be on the 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month from 9:30-11:30 at the Grange, starting on June 27. We will continue to meet on the first Thursday of the month through June 4. There will be 2 meetings in June. In October the meeting will be on Oct. 31 due to a conflict with the Grange. In November there will be no meeting, and the meeting in December will be on the 5<sup>th</sup>.

We will need to revise the business cards to reflect the change in meeting dates and times. Linda will order them for us from Vista Print. We will have a label-sticking party to update existing cards at our next meeting. Kirsten will set up a label with the QR code.

Treasurer's Report: \$5,814.02 in the checking account. In the money market we had \$37,792.15 as of the end of December.

Library Report: Bev needs "foster parents" for the books until she moves. She brought half the books to the meeting for "adoption." Next month she will bring the rest of the books.

We need to pare down our library holdings because many books have never been checked out. This may be due to lack of accessibility. There is a catalog of the library holdings. It was suggested that we put the catalog on the website. Linda will see if she can do that. There are items that need to be returned. The list was in an email with the RoseGround.

Education Report: Teacher agreements - we will standardize the teaching fee so we have an amount to propose to teachers. The standard fee will be \$325.00 per day. If teachers request a higher fee the request will be automatically approved if it is no more than 10% higher than the usual \$325. If the teacher asks for more than that the request will be brought to the group for approval. We are going to use a simplified version of the teaching agreement used by IOLI. We will give a stipend of \$40 per day to the person hosting the teacher for room, board, and transportation. Moved, seconded, and passed.

Classes are usually limited to 10-12 people. If there is a waitlist, members get first preference.

Elizabeth Peterson will teach Bruge and Beds on May 29 through 31 and will be hosted by Lise Driggers. Allie Marguccio will teach Idrija lace and has asked for 3 possible dates in fall 2026. The first weekend in November is proposed - 6, 7 & 8. Pauline will check if she can host. Second choice is November 13, 14 & 15. Her fee is \$55/hour. Class size is limited to 12 (2 more possible).Val will contact Allie to see if she is available.

Bev will reach out to Louise Palermo about attending our Lace Day to launch work on the Community Lace Project.

Henry Rose made a list of future demos. County fairs are not included on the list. Do we want to participate in the fairs this year? Yes on Clark County and the State fair, the others are questionable.

Val knows of a woodworker's festival. Free booths are available for other crafters. It's a 2-day event in March 2027. Val's husband is demonstrating bobbin turning. The event is in Albany at Linn County fairgrounds.

The next demo is at Polk County Museum on March 21 in Salem. Henry Rose passed around a sign-up sheet.

Sherry Campbell has been having health issues. She is getting out of tatting. She would like to donate her supplies and books for Lace Day. Bev will pick up the donations.

Lace Day: Tommie will take care of coffee and tea. We have purchased our own urn. We will have two sign-in tables. Marilyn passed around Lace Day sign-up for volunteering. Marilyn has contacted Kelly as a vendor and she asked what things we would like her to bring. Val can vend bobbins if someone can man her table. She will be out of town.

Marilyn asked us to hand out flyers when we demo. Also post at yarn and quilting shops near you.

Lace Day will be held at the Elsie Stuhr Center, 5550 SW Hall Blvd., Beaverton, on May 16. The building will be available from 8:30 - 3:00. The event will be from 10:00-2:00.

Next month members are asked to bring ideas for mini workshops.
