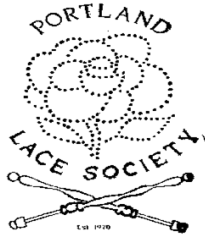

*Next meeting:* May 7. We will finish up the needle lace kits.

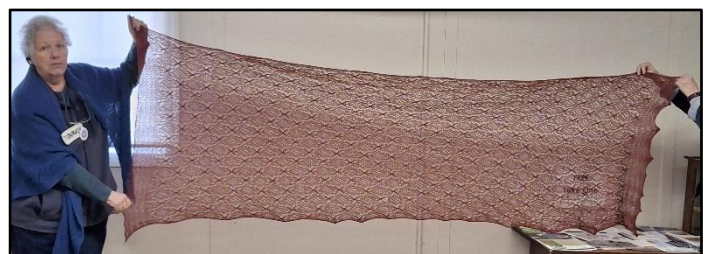
Melissa proposed closing meeting, seconded and passed.

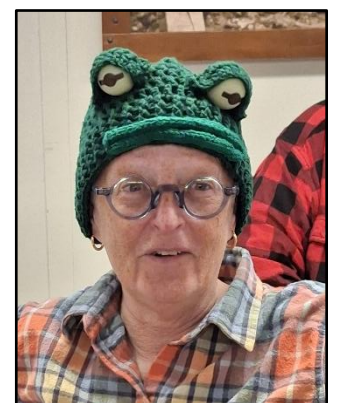


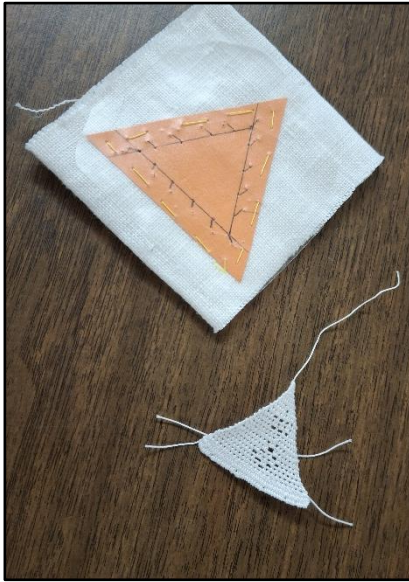
Tommy has been busy with shawl making. Including this free beauty called The Lucky Clover Lace Stole on Ravelry.

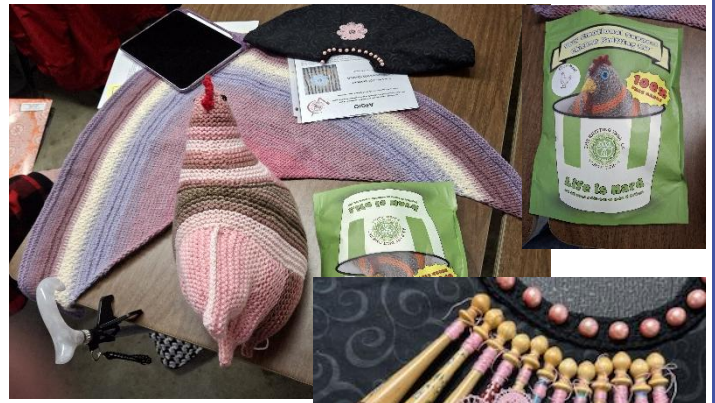
River is up to \$1565 for her fundraising using Frog hats for Friends of Seasonal and Service Workers.
